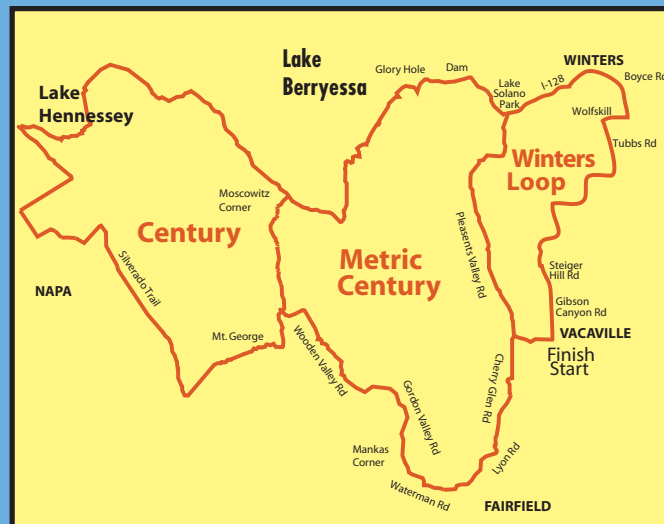

Directions from Sacramento:

From I-80 take the Mason Street exit and continue straight onto Depot Street. Turn left onto W. Monte Vista Avenue. Approximately one mile, Vacaville High School will be on the right.

Directions from San Francisco:

From I-80 take the Alamo/Merchant Street exit. Follow directions to Merchant Street and turn right onto Merchant. Follow Merchant all the way into town (approx. 3 mi.) and turn left onto Dobbins Street. Turn left onto W. Monte Vista Avenue. Vacaville High School will be on the right.

THE TOWN OF MONTICELLO

In the mid 19th century, a new American town, Monticello, came into existence in the Putah Creek Basin. It soon developed into a prosperous agricultural community during the early years of the 20th century. At this time, Berryessa Valley was a flat, fertile valley watered by Putah Creek, and the soil of the valley was considered among the most fertile in the country.

The town of Monticello stood in the center of the valley, surrounded by thousands of acres of land used to raise livestock and for dry land farming of grain. The subsequent development of a canal system for irrigation contributed to successful crops of pears, grapes, walnuts, alfalfa, and other grains, and to herds of cattle and horses.

However, you won't see the town of Monticello. As of late 1956-57 after the dam was built and the inhabitants moved from their homes and ranches the Monticello Valley was allowed to fill with water creating Lake Berryessa.

WINTERS LOOP

This 35-mile ride will take us on one of the local's favorite training loops. We'll ride out Pleasants Valley Road, where there will be a rest stop half way at Lake Solano for refreshments and snacks. Then into the bucolic town of Winters, back out through the rolling hills and working orchards and ranches heading back to Vacaville.

METRIC CENTURY RIDE

Although less difficult than the full century, this 100k (60 miles) is still very challenging. With undulating terrain like the full century, including "cardiac" climbs and swift descents, this ride will also go along vineyards and picturesque views. It travels along part of the stage 1 of the 2009 Tour of California race course. This is a great way for the beginner or intermediate rider to experience all three counties in a challenging ride. With 4 rest stops offering food, water and sports drinks, we will make sure to keep you going.

CENTURY RIDE

This classic 100-mile ride is a beauty and goes along much of stage 1 of the Tour of California race route. Overall, the challenge of this ride along with its beauty is unmatched in the area. The climb up Mt. George goes from almost sea level, up to 1,200 feet in elevation, then back down via one of the best descents around, and that's all before lunch! After lunch, we take a ride through Napa, passing through the scenic vineyards and onto what the pros ride in stage 1 of the California tour bike race as it winds its way past Lake Berryessa. This ride includes 5 catered rest stops.

POST RIDE

For all the rides, the day wraps up at Vacaville High School with a fine meal prepared by Murillo's Mexican Restaurant featuring **TRI-TIP**, rice and beans, salad and much more.

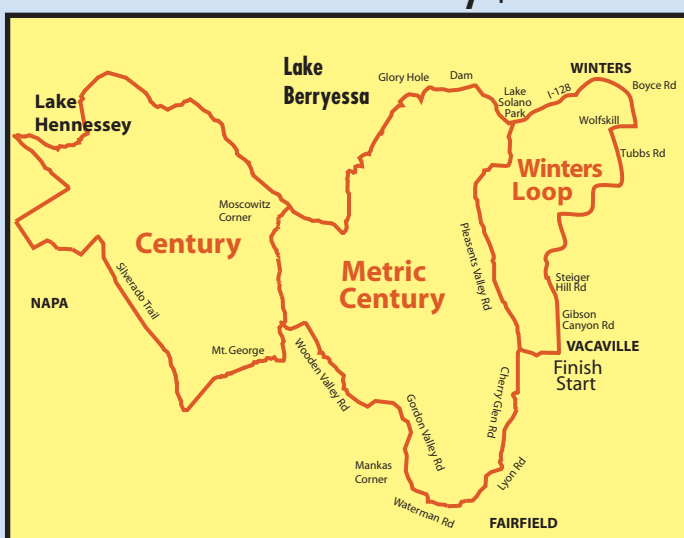
